

Notice of Municipal Election

Town of Aurora, North Carolina

A Municipal Election will be held on November 3rd, 2015 in the Town of Aurora, North Carolina to vote on two Commissioners seats. Polls will be open from 6:30 AM until 7:30 PM. The polling place will be located at the Aurora Community Building, 442 3rd St., Aurora, NC.

Absentee ballots are allowed. Requests for an absentee ballot must be made in writing and received in the Beaufort County Board of Elections office by 5:00 PM on Tuesday, October 27th, 2015. Absentee voting begins on October 2nd, 2015 and ends at 5:00 PM on November 2nd, 2015. The Board of Elections will meet on October 13th (5:00 pm), October 20th (5:00 pm), October 27th (5:00 pm), and November 2nd (5:00 pm) for the purpose of approving absentee ballot applications. One-stop absentee voting will be held in the board of elections office, 1308 Highland Drive, Suite 104, Washington, NC beginning October 22nd and ending Saturday, October 31st at 1:00 pm. One-stop voting hours are Monday through Friday 8:00 am to 5:00 pm. Saturday, October 31st, is the only Saturday the Office will be open during the One Stop period and will be closing at 1:00 pm. Canvass Day will be held at 11:00 am in the Beaufort County Board of Elections Office in Washington, NC on November 10^h, 2015.

All residents of the Town of Aurora who are registered to vote with the Beaufort County Board of Elections may vote in this election. Voters who are previously registered need not re-register for this election. Those residents of the Town of Aurora who are not registered to vote must register on or before Friday, October 9th, 2015 in order to be eligible to vote in this election. Alternatively you may register and, if eligible then vote at the Board of Elections one-stop site. Any voter who has moved outside his or her precinct but within the county since the last election should notify the Board of Elections in writing by October 9th, 2015.
